Overview

Caforio graduated *magna cum laude* from UCLA, where he was a two-time All-American Attorney and won the American Mock Trial Association National Championship twice. He graduated from Yale Law School, where he served as a Senior Editor of the *Yale Law & Policy Review*, and clerked on the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit for Judge Sidney R. Thomas.
