Overview

Eve Levin rejoined Susman Godfrey after serving as a Bristow Fellow in the Office of the Solicitor General, United States Department of Justice, where she assisted with Supreme Court litigation on behalf of the federal government. Previously, she served as a law clerk to Chief Judge Sri Srinivasan of the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit and Judge J. Paul Oetken of the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York.

At Columbia Law School, Ms. Levin received multiple named prizes, including the Ruth Bader Ginsburg prize for having earned James Kent academic honors in each of her three years, the Samuel I.
