Overview

Ravi Bhalla represents plaintiffs and defendants in federal and state court across the nation. He has handled a variety of commercial litigation matters, including contract disputes, breaches of fiduciary duty, theft and infringement of intellectual property, and large-scale class actions.

Through all stages of litigation, he is frequently the principal drafter of briefing submitted to the court. He has also taken and defended dozens of depositions, often eliciting critical testimony.
