LANDMARK WINS

Mr. Shepard has appeared in courts in Arkansas, California, D.C., Delaware, Florida, Illinois, Kentucky, Michigan, New York, Nevada, New Jersey, Puerto Rico, Tennessee, and Texas, racking up precedent-setting wins along the way. Some of these victories include:

- Securing settlements valued at \$135 million in a False Claims Act case against Verizon, AT&T, and Sprint over allegations of fraudulently overbilling government entities in California and Nevada.
- Representing Walmart Inc. in constitutional litigation, securing a judgment that Puerto Rico’s discriminatory transfer tax violated the Dormant Commerce Clause—a trial victory unanimously affirmed by the First Circuit.
