Susman Godfrey wins high marks again in the annual Vault Survey. Vault ranked Susman Godfrey the #1 Litigation Boutique ranking for the ninth year in a row. The full results reflect the firm's high performance in several areas, including:

- **#1 U.S. Litigation Boutique:** Susman Godfrey earned this ranking for the *ninth* year in a row. Susman Godfrey has been ranked #1 every year since the inception of the ranking in 2012
- **Vault "Top 100":** Susman Godfrey is again included on the Vault "Top 100" list of the best law firms in the United States and has moved up eight spots since last year.
- **Regional Leader:** The firm's Houston location ranked third in Vault's 2020 Best Law Firms in Texas, up from fourth in the 2019 rankings.
