

Susman Godfrey Named Class Action Firm of the Year by National Law Journal's Elite Trial Lawyers

- been selected by the court as lead counsel in some are calling "the biggest class action in history," *In re: Qualcomm Patent Licensing Antitrust Litigation*,

- been appointed by the Court to serve as co-lead counsel to the plaintiff DirectTV subscribers who allege that DirecTV's exclusive NFL Sunday Ticket package violates federal antitrust laws.
